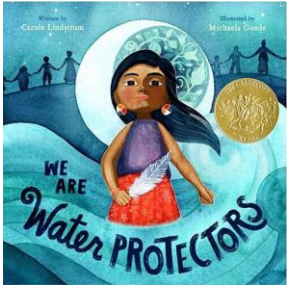

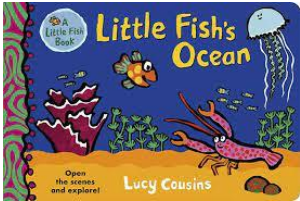

Reading as few as five books over the summer months helps kids beat the “summer slide” and retain the skills they learned during the school year. Kids also need to see the adults in their life reading. The best way to show a child that reading is an important, fun activity—that it isn’t just something we do at school—is to model reading yourself.

Reading Readiness Tips:

This is a story about Indigenous People written by an Indigenous person. When picking out books with your child you should absolutely let them read what they are drawn to but be sure to introduce diverse books, in all senses of the word. Reading diverse books provides opportunities for kids to see themselves and build empathy with others who are not like them through stories.
