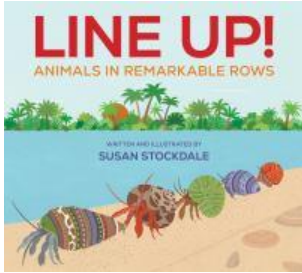

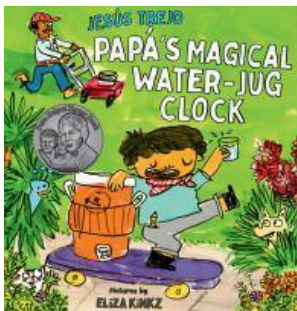

Reading Readiness Tips:

Line Up! is filled with rich vocabulary, like amble, scamper, and all of the animal names. Vocabulary is knowing the meaning of words and is an important early literacy skill to help children get ready to read. Research has shown that children with larger vocabularies have an easier time when they are learning to read. Try to make connections between images and real-life examples whenever possible. When you read with older children, you can point out new vocabulary words, talk about their meanings and use those words in everyday conversation.
